

## Supply lists 2011-2012

### **Kindergarten:**

Pencils (best: # 1 Ticonderoga)  
2 large pink erasers  
1 box crayons  
1 box Crayola Markers  
2 large glue sticks  
1 Box of tissues  
Boys – 1 Box gallon sized zip-lock bags  
Girls – 1 Box sandwich sized zip-lock bags  
2 Mead Primary Journals  
1 pack of sheet protectors  
1 bottom-pocket folder, durable for home-school communications

*To bring throughout the school year:*

Hand- sanitizer  
Hand soap  
Clorox wipes  
Healthy Snacks

### **1<sup>st</sup> Grade:**

1 composition book, wide ruled  
Lysol disinfecting wipes

## **3<sup>rd</sup> Grade:**

2 Boxes 24 Ct. #2 Pencils  
1 Box 24 Ct. Crayola Crayons  
1 5" Sharp Fiskar Scissors  
2 Pack Dry Erase markers  
3 Pocket folders with brads  
2 Pkgs 200 Ct. Filler Paper – Wide ruled  
2 Boxes Facial Tissues  
1 Container Disinfecting Wipes  
1 package of Baby Wipes  
1 Zippered pencil pouch (No pencil boxes)  
4 Paper Towel Rolls  
1 Spiral notebook (1 subject)  
1 Box Ziploc bags (Quart or gallon)  
3 Big Pink Erasers

## **4<sup>th</sup> Grade:**

1 composition notebook (no spirals)  
1 box tissues  
1 roll paper towels  
40 cap erasers  
4 or more glue sticks  
1 bottle hand sanitizer (except for 4C/Nelson)  
6 or more folders with pockets... one should be plastic that can last all year  
(for daily work and weekly homework packet)  
72 ct #2 pencils (from Office Depot/Office Max/ or similar). No dollar store pencils please.

*Note: Space in 4th grade rooms is limited. NO rolling backpacks*

## **5<sup>th</sup> grade:**

- 1 pair student scissors
- 2 pencil sharpeners (hand held, metallic – plastic breaks easily)
- 1 12-inch ruler
- 2 reams of white copy paper
- 2 three-pronged folders with pockets
- 4 packs of loose-leaf paper (wide rule only)
- 2 packs of #2 pencils
- 2 glue sticks and or bottled glue
- 5 spiral notebooks (wide rule only) – 5 if they are single subjects or only 2 if they are 5 subject notebooks
- 1 box pencil crayons
- 1 pack fine tip (skinny) dry erase markers
- 1 pack highlighters
- 3 marbled composition books
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer (large or small)
- 2 boxes of tissues or as many as you can bring
- 2 rolls of paper towels or as many as you can bring
- 1 bottle Lysol or any other antibacterial spray
- 1 bottle surface cleaner (antibacterial and safe for use around children)
- wipes – as many as you can bring (hand wipes and surface wipes are needed)
- 1 package of geometry templates – This should feature a circle graph, protractor (both full and semi protractor)

\*Please remember that these are consumable supplies and will need to be replaced (as needed) throughout the year. More might not be needed if every child brings in all or most of the supplies on the list. Suggestion—buy extra while on sale or try to buy supplies on the list periodically throughout the summer.
